RE: Rescinding of Precautionary Drinking Water Advisory

Please be advised that the Water Security Agency is rescinding the Precautionary Drinking Water Advisory (PDWA) for the Town of Dalmeny's distribution system which was issued on September 3 2018, effective immediately this Wednesday September 5, 2018 at 3:00 p.m.

All necessary samples have been taken, and have come back with good results. No positive bacteria were found in the two sets of samples. The system has been re-pressurized and all of the proper measures have been taken to put the distribution system back into service.

In consultation with the Saskatchewan Health Authority, we agree no potential health risk currently exists for the Town of Dalmeny's distribution system and the advisory previously issued is hereby removed.
